"Father and Mother were young pioneers in Iowa, with their parents. They had grown up as neighbors; and at the ages of 21 and 18, were married September 1, 1859." ..."They had very little of this world's goods with which to begin married life, but both knew very well how to work and save. They added to their income as farmers by teaching school; she in the summer and he in the winter, "... "He (Allen) was a successful farmer in the highest sense of the word, and she was a real homemaker. Farm work was always done on time without rush or excitement. As their three boys and one girl were passing through their teen years. The fires were kept burning with good reading, family devotions, croquet and other simple games were provided for instruction, spiritual growth and physical relaxation,".
