

Letter from John Coalson to Hattie and Hugh - Nov 30, 1905

Nov the 30 1905

Wel Hattie & hugh this is thanks given Day. Will wright you a few lins to night. I Do thank god that we air all well & I am thankful that my Little family is all a Living and and I thank god that we can see one an other once in a while. I would hav bin more thankful if we could of bin all to geather to Day. We had fried chickin & cake. Was all the good things wee had for diner. Has Bin pretty cold to Day & yester Day. Went too Weatherford yesterday. It Looked Like it was going to get warmer & so I Did Knot Kill Eny hogs. Bin getting Wood to Day. Whin it gets cold again I think I will have som pork. I wonder what you air all doing to knight. All in bed I spect for it is near 9 o'clock. Lam's bin spinding the Day with us all. ?a came up to knight. Staid a while. Never got my cattle in the field until this morning. Had to stay out thair & mind them out of the cain. Liked to freeze. Will haf to do the same thing in the morning. I scraptd out the \$10 Dollars Worth after you Left & Did knot get it all then. Will close for this time.
